TO VOTE, YOU MUST DARKEN THE OVAL COMPLETELY (●).            2. Use a black ink pen to mark the ballot.            3. To vote for a WRITE-IN candidate, write in the name on the line provided AND darken the oval completely.</p> <p><b>4. DO NOT CROSS OUT OR ERASE.</b> If you make a mistake, ask for a new ballot.</p>	<p><b>NOTE</b></p> <p>Registered voters who arrive to vote without an acceptable form of photo ID may go home to retrieve their photo ID, without signing in, and return with their ID prior to the close of polls to cast a regular ballot.</p>
				<p><b>NOTE</b></p> <p>Alternatively, the voter will be offered a provisional ballot. The voter will still be able to cast their vote, but their ballot will only count if the voter presents an acceptable form of ID to their county election office, in person, on or before the Tuesday following the election.</p>
