Johnson Fire Station Bond  
Question

Shall the Village of Johnson, Nebraska, borrow money and pledge the property and credit of the Village upon its negotiable bonds in the principal amount of not to exceed Nine Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$950,000) for the purpose of constructing, acquiring and equipping an approximately 4,000 square foot addition to the existing Fire Station of the Village, which may include additional apparatus bays for equipment, decontamination room, and ADA accessible restroom, together with related modifications, furnishings, equipment and improvements for such facilities; with such bonds to be issued in one or more series, at such time or times, to bear interest at such rate or rates, to be sold at such prices and to become due at such time or times as may be fixed by, or determined at the direction of the Chairperson and the Trustees of the Village of Johnson; and Shall the Village cause to be levied and collected annually a special levy of taxes on the taxable value of all the taxable property in the Village, in addition to all other taxes, if not paid from other revenue sources, in an amount sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on said bonds as such principal and interest become due?
